£3 Bus Fare Cap

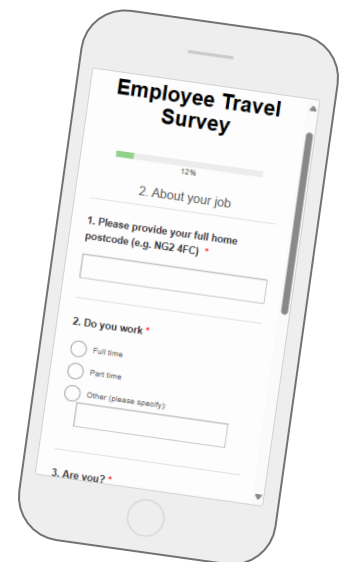
Now it is the start of the year, it has been announced that a new £3 bus fare cap will be in operation for 2025 until December 31st. During this period all adult single journeys will be capped at £3, keeping buses an affordable alternative to commuting by car.

If you're wondering which bus you should get to take advantage of the low fares, trentbarton operate Skylink services to Nottingham, Derby, Leicester and Loughborough, whilst Diamond Bus run the Airway 9 service to Burton-on-Trent. You can catch each service at the bus interchange by the entrance to the site and then take the EMG shuttle bus the rest of the way for free. So why not give bus travel a try this year for a cheap and easy journey to work.
